HOW WE MAKE AN IMPACT

Poverty is greatest among single mother led households. Single parent families are the fastest growing families in the USA. We help level the financial, educational and career playing fields for this very vital part of our communities.

These families learn to set and achieve goals and see college as attainable through our college readiness program. HAAFP Scholars get the right tools and financial and emotional support to persevere through college, through our Scholarships and Life Skills workshops. Trained mentors empower them to reach their full potential and earn degrees. Our scholars break the glass ceiling of higher education for teen moms. 75% of our scholars continue in college and graduate compared to the national teen mother graduation rate of <2%.
